ANALYTICAL APPROACH

THEMATIC APPROACH

The approach in which the Mufassir seeks to study the Qur'an by taking up a particular theme from among the various themes dealt by the Qur'an.





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DEFINITION

The Qur'anic science which interprets different issues and themes in view of the Qur'anic objectives through the study of one Surah or more or through multiple Ayaat.


